**SouthWest Washington Paranormal Research investigated Mission Mill Museum. The investigation team consisted of six researchers using various equipment such as; Video cameras, night camera recorders, many different brands of digital cameras, digital voice recorders, cassette recorders, temperature readers, EMF detectors, motion detectors, & motion cameras. On this investigation we had author Jefferson Davis & his wife join us for part of the evening.**

**Our first place at Mission Mills was The Jason Lee House, Some of the researchers were setting up video equipment, while other researchers walked around the house taking temperature & EMF readings. Temperature reading baseline stayed between 61\*-63\* throughout the downstairs & upstairs of the house, no EMF was detected throughout. One of our temperature reader's batteries drained, after putting new batteries in them drained again. It would not work for the rest of the night. Researchers took pictures throughout the house & captured a few small orbs. At 10:14 pm we sat down & did our first EVP session, nothing notably happened during that session. We left a night camera recorder running in this house while we went to the next.**

**Our second place was Pleasant Grove Church, built in 1857 & moved there in 1984 A couple researchers walked around the church taking temperature & EMF readings. Temperature reading baseline stayed between 55\* throughout, no EMF was detected. We took pictures & captured a few moving orbs. We started our second EVP session, nothing notably happened during that session. One researcher set up a recording system & a motion detector in the church to leave running while we went to the next place. The motion detector did not go off all night.**

**Our third place was The Parsonage House, A couple researchers walked around the house taking temperature & EMF readings. Temperature**

reading baseline stayed between 65.6\*throughout the downstairs & upstairs of the house, no EMF was detected throughout. One of our only other temperature reader's batteries drained, after that neither of the temperature readers would work for the rest of the night. Researchers took pictures throughout the house & captured a few small orbs. We started our third EVP session, nothing notably happened during that session. One researcher left a full sized cassette recorder running in this house while we went to the next place.

Our fourth place was John Boone House, built in 1847 & moved here in 1972 We could not take temperature readings both our reader's batteries kept draining until they stopped working. There were no EMF readings detected throughout the house. Researchers took pictures throughout the house & captured a few small orbs. One of the investigators head light started to flicker then went back to normal. We started our fourth EVP session, during this session we heard a knock sound. It was just the cat outside of the door. During this session one member heard voices outside the door, it was from a wedding party that was inside of the Mill. Nothing notably happened during this session that was not easily explained. One investigator left a mini cassette recorder running while we went to the mill area.

Our fifth place was the mill area We left a camcorder running in the boiler room. Researchers took pictures throughout the place & didn't capture anything on camera. No EMF was detected. On the first floor of the Mill researchers took pictures throughout the floor & captured a few moving orbs. The batteries drained in one researcher's camera, she had to replace them with new ones. No EMF was detected. We moved up to the second floor & took pictures we captured a few small orbs. No EMF was detected. We moved up to the fourth floor, No EMF was detected. Researchers took pictures throughout the floor & didn't capture anything on camera. Two of the member's camera's batteries drained again so they were no longer able to take pictures. We started our fifth & last EVP session, during this session nothing notably happened.
